Contra-indications to MRI

The main risk involved in MRI is the effect of ferromagnetic objects placed in the magnetic field. Thus, MRI is not suited to patients requiring monitoring devices. Conventional pacemakers, ferromagnetic aneurism clips, neuro-stimulators, and other implanted ferromagnetic or electrical devices are total contra indications to MRI. Care must be taken with patients with embedded metallic ocular foreign bodies or shrapnel. All patients who have performed welding or have worked with metal will require an X-ray of the orbits to exclude the possibility of embedded foreign ocular bodies.
